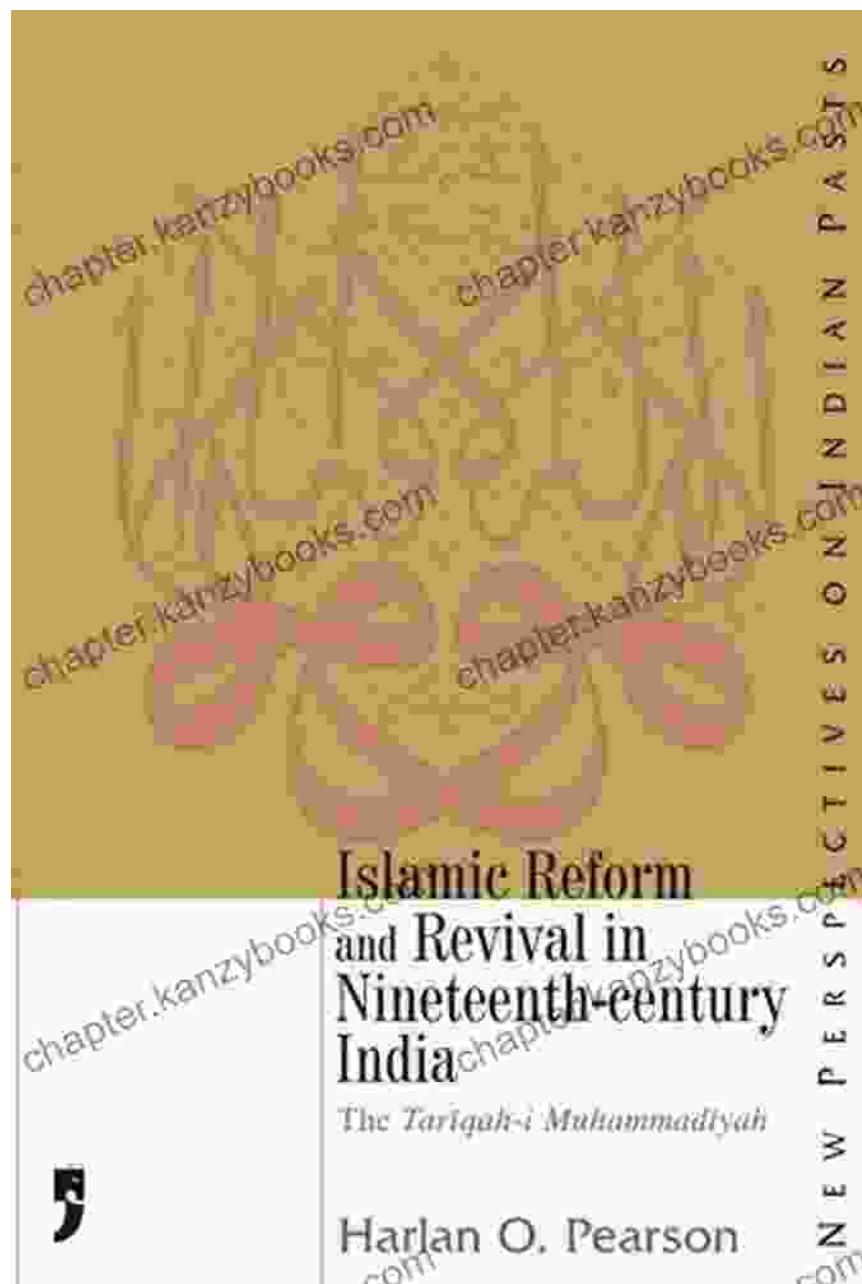

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

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Since the fall of the Mughals, one of the most important and influential Muslim scholars in Islamic revival in India was Shah Waliullah (r.h). 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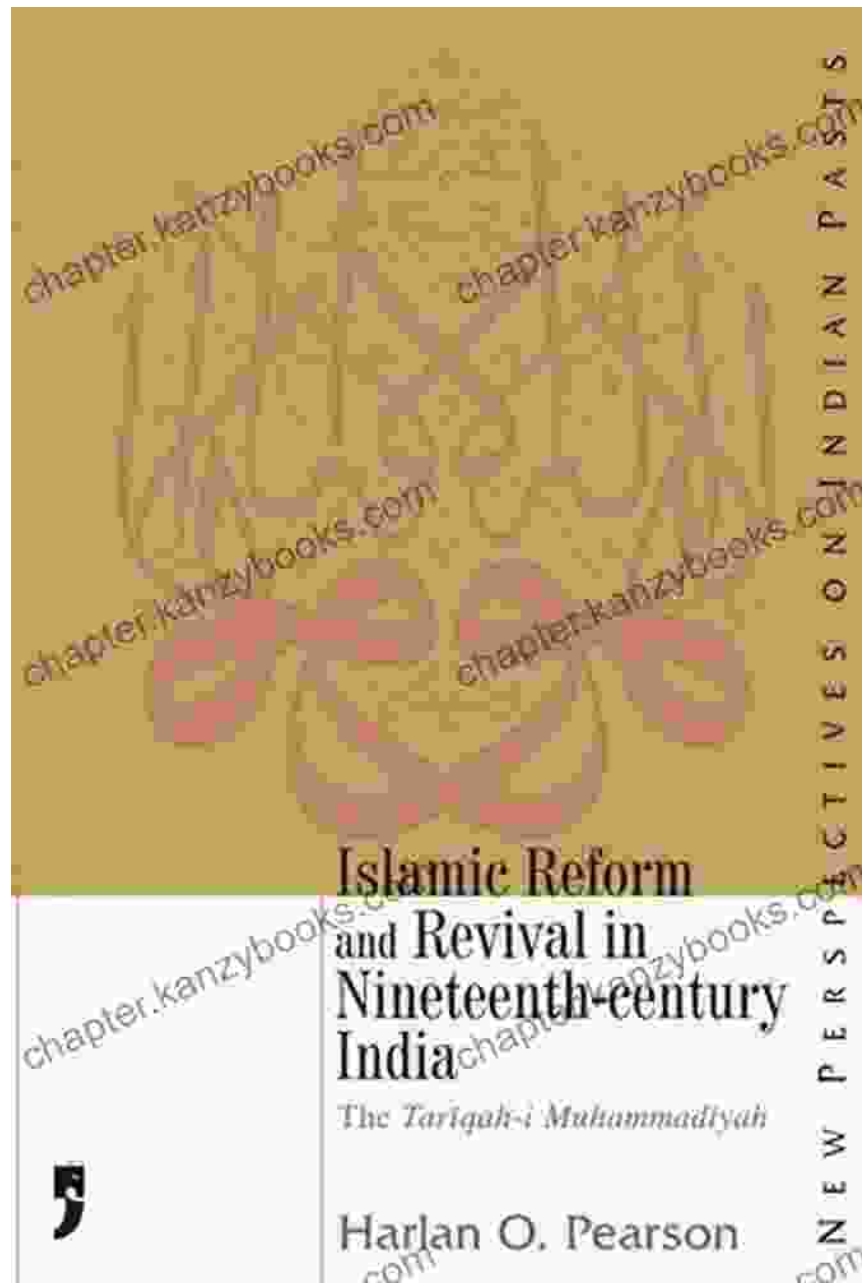
Shah Waliullah Dehlawi

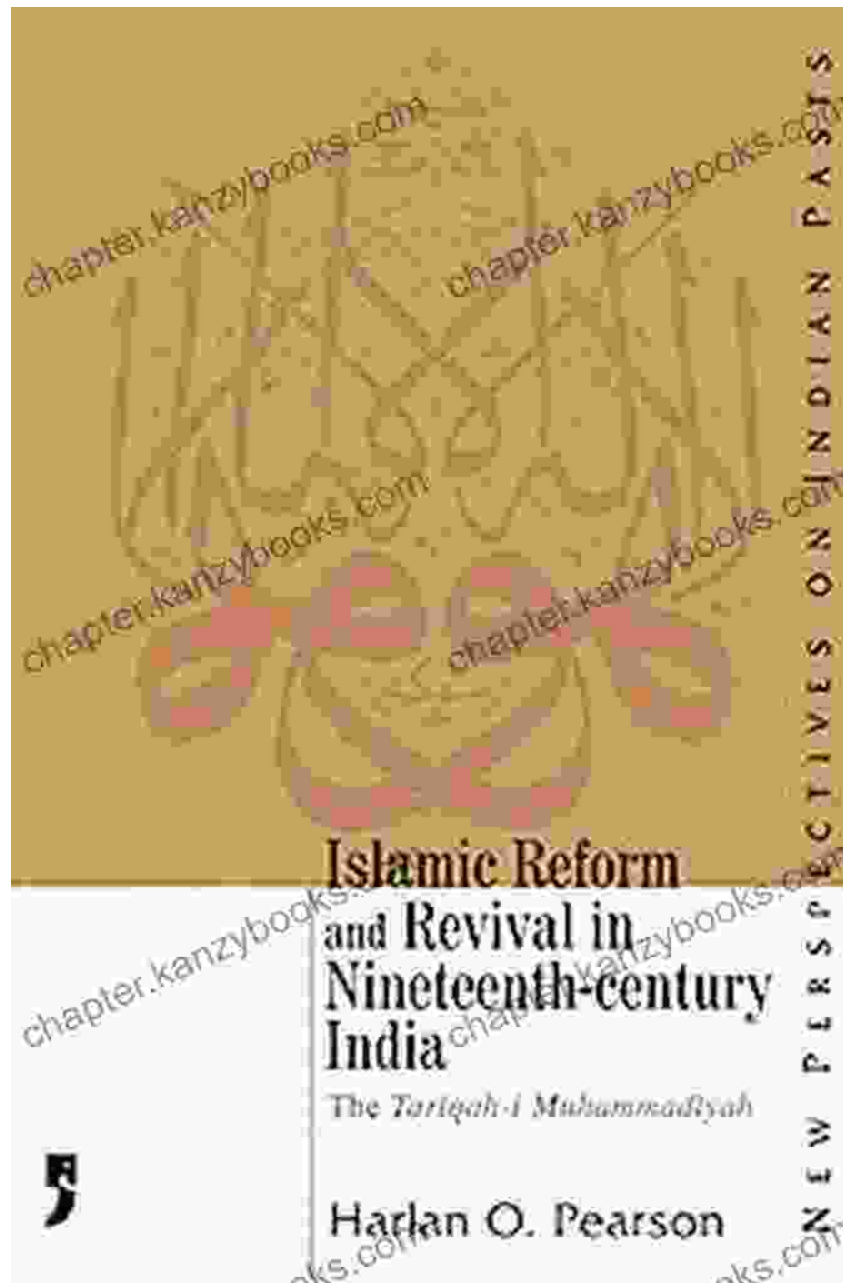
Sayyid Ahmad Khan

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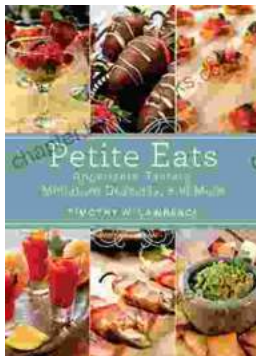
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
