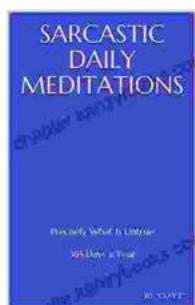


Precisely What Is Untrue 365 Days Year?

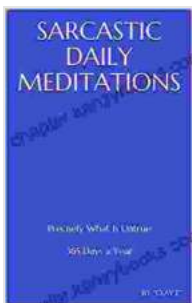

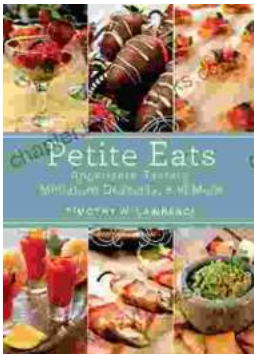
